Division 15 (Educational Psychology) of the American Psychological Association seeks nominations for the 2023 Richard E. Snow Award for Early Contributions. Given annually, this award is named to a scholar who:

1. has completed their doctoral work within the past ten years (i.e., between the dates of January 1, 2014 and January 1, 2024)
2. has made significant research contributions to the field of educational psychology, and
3. is a member of APA Division 15 at the time of consideration.

Those interested in submitting a nomination for this award (including a self-nomination) may email electronic copies of the following to Andrew Elliot, Award Committee Chair (andrew.elliott@rochester.edu):

1. a nomination letter describing the contributions of the nominee to the field of educational psychology,
2. the individual's vitae,
3. a representative reprint of the individual's research, and
4. a statement indicating how the nominee has acknowledged the essential role of participants and communities in their scholarship and/or how they have replenished participants and communities that have supported their scholarship.
